Board of Directors' Basketball Hoops and Other Sport Equipment Standards

It is the intention of the HOA Board of Directors to define what is and is not permitted, in accordance with our governing documents; Declaration, Article V, Section 5.28, as well as to address other sport equipment that is not currently provided for in our governing documents.

The Ellingsworth Residential Community Association Board of Directors does hereby adopt the following:

The owners of the lot in which the sporting equipment is placed, understands that they take full responsibility for any damage, harm, or injury, that may be caused while equipment is outside of their home, and will at all times, hold the Ellingsworth Residential Community Association harmless.

Basketball Hoops:

- Only portable basketball hoops are to be permitted. No permanent poles are to be placed in the ground, and no backboards shall be allowed to be attached to any homes.
- Portable basketball hoops may only be used during daylight hours.
- Portable hoops may be placed on the driveway, or the grass at the edge of the road, directly in front of the owner's home, while in use.
- Portable hoops must be maintained in good condition, with no rips in the netting allowed.

Other Sporting Equipment:

- All additional sporting equipment shall be stored inside the garage, behind one's fence, or in such a manner as to not be seen by one's neighbors when not in use, and outside of daylight hours.
- This shall include, but not be limited to:
 - o Soccer goals, and assorted equipment
 - o Lacrosse goals, Sticks, and other assorted equipment
 - o Any other sport activity not listed herein
